Pre-planning enquiry: Confirmation of sufficient capacity based on agreed Infrastructure Phasing Plan

Development:

The site comprises of land both to north and south of Goldworth Road – GU21 6JT. Numbers 15-29 Goldsworth Road and 8 Church Street West sit to the north of the site whilst 20-32 Goldworth Road site to the south.

Redevelopment of 15-32 Goldsworth Road to provide 965 dwellings (C3) and 3,202m2 of commercial space (use classes A1-A4, B1a & D1/D2) across four tower blocks.

Redevelopment of 8 Church Street West to provide 1,896m2 homeless shelter (Sui Generis).

Foul water: Foul I water from the proposed development on Goldsworth Road will connect by gravity to upstream of MH3502 & MH3504 & MH2506.

Foul water from the proposed development at 8 Church Street West will connect by gravity to existing 150mm diameter on Church Street West.

We're pleased to confirm that based on your delivery programme, we will provide sufficient foul water capacity in our sewerage network to serve your development.
