NOTES OF PRE-INQUIRY CMC

Meeting held virtually at 1000 hours on Thursday 2 September 2021

- 1. The Inquiry will be held in the Council Chamber at The Civic Offices, Gloucester Square, Woking GU21 6YL.
- 2. The Inquiry will commence at 1000 hours on Tuesday 30 November 2021 with subsequent sitting days commencing at 0930 hours.
- 3. The 10 day Inquiry is scheduled to be on 30/10-03/12, 07/12-10/12 and 14/12-15/12. However, it is hoped by all parties that evidence will be completed by 10/12 and that closing statements will be heard on 14/12.
- 4. The Inquiry is scheduled to be a face to face event but if any party wishes to be heard virtually then this will be accommodated. The Council shall, in this event, make the necessary arrangements.
- 5. If circumstances dictate that a face to face Inquiry is not possible then the event will proceed on a virtual basis.
- 6. The three main parties shall submit their Inquiry Timetable Forms no later than Tuesday 9 November.
- 7. The date for exchange of Proofs of Evidence is Tuesday 2 November. Rebuttal Proofs of Evidence shall be submitted no later than Friday 19 November.
- 8. The three main parties shall all contribute to a Statement of Common Ground which shall be submitted no later than Friday 19 November.
- 9. A Draft Planning Obligation shall be submitted no later than Friday 19 November and a signed and dated Planning Obligation shall be submitted before the close of the Inquiry.
- 10. Principal application drawings and models shall be displayed in the Council Chamber and a full set of application drawings shall be made available for the Inspector at the opening of the Inquiry.
- 11. The Appellant's Agent shall be responsible for preparing a set of Core Documents which shall be stored electronically and made available through a link on the Council's website. If any party wishes to receive a hard copy of any Core Document then the Council shall make this available for them.
- 12. The Inspector will make unaccompanied site visits before and during the Inquiry. Each main party shall, if they wish, provide the Inspector with a list, at the opening of the Inquiry, of places that they wish him to visit on his site visits.
- 13. It is not expected that an accompanied site visit will be necessary but if it is then appropriate arrangements will be made during the Inquiry.
